WHAT

The Regional Durable Solutions Secretariat (ReDSS) and the Somalia NGO Consortium (SNC) are organizing an Evidence week on displacement in Somalia to support knowledge sharing and research uptake to inform better durable solutions programing and policies based on evidence

WHY

The objective is to bring and discuss evidence collected by various stakeholders over the past 2 years on durable solutions and displacement in Somalia to better understand social changes and aspirations of displacement-affected communities
